- Operate:
 - Pick-up truck
 - Riding lawn mowers
 - Weed trimmers
- Maintain airfield grounds related to landscaping, mowing, fertilizing, weed control, flower planting and watering
- Paint and fill cracks and joints on Runway, taxiway, apron, parking lot, and roadway surfaces
- Remove debris from all paved surfaces
- Assist in shop repairs of heavy equipment
- Perform other duties as directed

Note: Most of the position's functions will involve manual outdoor labour through all weather conditions.

Requirements:

Education

- Engaged in full-time studies at a recognized secondary or post-secondary institution with the intention of returning to full-time studies at a similar institution within the calendar year.
